Light The Night – During the Event

Route Marshal – Guide walkers along the route, and make sure it is safe; **Registration** – Register walkers for the walk and take in their donations; **Team Tent** – Help with the team tents, registering the team and so forth; **Food Tent** – Give out and organize the food and beverages tent, but NO food preparation is done; **Children’s Tent** – Help facilitate games and activities for children, and keep the tent running, while maintaining it in an orderly fashion; **Site Host** – Answer questions about the event and where people/tents are, funnel people towards the correct tents, and make sure people are taken care of; **Traffic Marshal** – Help coordinate traffic away from the LTN event streets, and make sure people cross safely; **Various Other Positions** (Underlined positions are the most important ones)
