



LTN Auction FAQs

The LLSC will be organizing a National LTN Auction this year! Please refer to the FAQs below, and reach out to your local staff contact if you have any other questions.

1. When and where will the auction be held?

The auction will be held online from September 20th until September 30th.

2. Can I submit items for the auction and receive credit towards my fundraising efforts?

Yes! However the item must have a minimum fair market value of \$150 to be included in the auction. Following the auction, and upon receipt of funds, the amount the item sells for will be attributed to your fundraising efforts. All required fields in the submission form must be completed in order to receive credit for the funds.

3. How do I submit items for the auction?

Submitted auction items will need to be approved by National staff to be included in the auction. Auction items must be submitted by Sept 6th FIRM and must have a minimum fair market value of \$150. No items will be able to be submitted to the auction after August 30th.

4. Can businesses or individuals who donate items to the auction receive an official tax receipt or letter of acknowledgement?

Official tax receipts will not be provided. However, a Gift In Kind donation acknowledgement letter can be issued as long as proof of the fair market value has been provided. Please email your local staff contact to arrange for a GIK letter.

5. Will the business or individual who donates an item be recognized on the auction website?

Yes, the donor's name will be listed along with the description of the item.

6. Can an auction item winner receive a tax receipt?

No, auction item winners will not be provided with tax receipts.

7. How will the winners be notified?

All winners will be notified through the auction website.

8. How will auction items be paid for?

In order to place a bid, the individual must register and provide a valid credit card number. Upon the auction closing, the credit cards of all successful bidders will automatically be charged.

9. How will auction winners receive their items?

Following payment, the participant who secured the item will be provided with the contact info of the winner so that they can make arrangements for pick-up or shipping. The winner will be responsible for any shipping costs. The location of the item will be included in the item description so that bidders will know which items are local to them prior to placing their bids.
